School of Social Work Policy on CECs: Any field instructor who wishes to receive CECs for the SIFI **must attend 100% of the 14 hour seminar**, complete an application and pay a \$15.00 recording fee **on line**. Attendance is taken at each session.

In order to receive a certificate (but not the CECs) you **must attend 80% of the total number of hours of the seminar.**
