

## Liberal Arts Requirement

MSW applicants must have a Bachelor’s degree or close to completing their Bachelor’s degree from an accredited college or university which demonstrates a liberal arts foundation. This coursework may include **at least one course from each of the following categories** - the Natural Sciences; the Social and Behavioral Sciences; and the Humanities and Arts.

Please note, you do not need a degree in one of these areas. The UConn School of Social Work encourages applicants from all academic backgrounds as long as the liberal arts requirement is met.
